Health Policy for Risk Reduction Methods for Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS)

Effective January 1, 2003

- All Infants under the age of 12 months old shall be placed on their backs on a firm tight fitting mattress for sleep in a crib.
- Waterbeds, sofas, soft mattresses, pillows and other soft surfaces shall be prohibited as infant sleeping surfaces.
- All pillows, quilts, comforters, sheepskins, stuffed toys and all other products shall be removed from the crib.
- The infant's head shall remain uncovered during sleep.
- Unless the child has a note from a physician specifying otherwise, infants shall be placed in a supine (back) position for sleeping to lower risks of SIDS.
- When infants can easily turn over from the supine (back) to the prone (stomach) position, they shall be put down to sleep on their back, but allowed to adopt whatever position they prefer for sleep.
- Unless a doctor specifies the need for a positioning device that restricts movement within the child's crib, such devices shall not be used.
